## **DECISION II**

Referring to Decision III adopted in Vienna on 10 September 2012 regarding, inter alia, the theme, the general rapporteur and the programme of the Congress, the Circle of Presidents, gathered in Vienna on the occasion of the XVI<sup>th</sup> Congress of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts on 12 and 13 May 2014, unanimously decides that

- the five working sessions of the Congress will be chaired, in turn, by the President of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Austria (first session and closing session), the President of the Constitutional Court of Hungary (second session), the President of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Italy (third session) and the President of the Federal Constitutional Court of Germany (fourth session);
- 2. after the presentation of the general report during the first session, the subsequent sessions of the Congress dedicated to the sub-themes known to all members will be introduced through contributions to the discussion or input papers and concluded with plenary discussions;
- 3. the contributions prepared for presentation at the Congress (contributions to the discussion and input papers) will be included in the publication containing the general report and all national reports;
- 4. the national reports submitted by the members can be updated if the members so wish by the end of August 2014 for printing and publication of the general report and the national reports in English and French (pursuant to Art. 9 para. 2 Statute and Art. 12. para. 5 Conference Regulations);

5. publication of the general report, the national reports and the contributions at the Congress (contributions to the discussion and input papers) is scheduled for the end of 2014.
